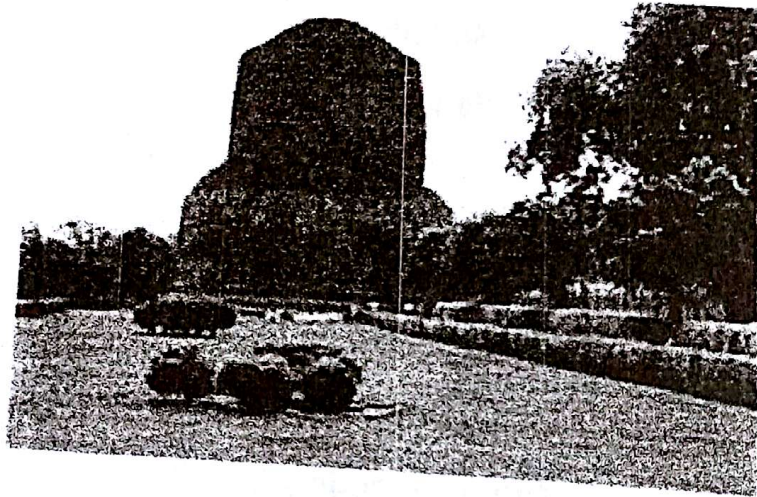
### Question 4
